



HEALTH AND SAFETY ASSESSMENT

Part 1

This involves a run through of current health and safety practices being followed by your company.

This part of the assessment will take approximately two hours. It identifies how your company is currently complying with relevant health and safety and safe regulations.

This part of the assessment will cover topics such as:

- Healthy and safety policy
- Risk assessments
- Emergency procedures
- Staff training
- Safe working practices
- First aid provision
- Accident reporting
- Compensation claims

It is advisable that a senior manager is present.

Part 2

For this, there will be an inspection of the site and/or working practices, to identify the following:

- Hazards in the workplace
- Working practices being followed
- COSHH (Control Of Substances Hazardous to Health) requirements
- P.P.E (Personal Protective Equipment) requirements
- Emergency provision (e.g. fire exits, fire extinguishers, etc)
- General health and safety

The 'HealthAndSafetyWise' advisor should be accompanied by a member of staff during this period.

Part 3

This consists of a debrief, where the 'HealthAndSafetyWise' advisor will run through the findings of the assessment.

Again, it is advisable that a senior manager is present.

Part 4

Finally, a written report will be created, detailing the findings of the visit and recommendations of action needed to be taken to bring your company inline with relevant regulations.

Costs
